


Defying the odds

Brandon was born with cerebral palsy, affecting all four limbs, and was kept in hospital on oxygen for the first 9 months of his life. Despite doctors saying he would never walk or eat normally, now at 12 years old he is achieving amazing things.

Though his cerebral palsy has affected him in various ways, including breathing problems and fatigue, he is living a very full and happy life, supported by his family, case manager and a great team of support workers.

He trains with a junior football team every week and is learning to swim, which he finds very challenging. "He gets frustrated but he's very determined," says Tracey, Brandon's mum. "He's exceeded everything we ever thought was possible."


